ABOUT

The North Korea Freedom Coalition, joined by human rights activists and organizations around the world, will be delivering letters on **September 24**, to embassies and consulates of the People's Republic of China appealing for safe passage for North Korean refugees.

We are asking human rights activists in cities with Chinese embassies to attempt to deliver by hand copies of an appeal re-

questing that China abide by its international treaty obligations citing and including the letter that Justice Michael Kirby sent to the PRC United Nations mission in Geneva, in December of 2013.

Activists are also taking action in cities without PRC consulates as Solidarity Cities to plan events educating the public about the wrongful repatriation of North Korean men, women and children in China.

WE ARE ASKING CHINA TO

- 1) Stop forcing North Koreans in China to return to North Korea.
- 2) Permit people from North Korea to travel to any country they choose.
- 3) Grant refugee status to North Koreans in China.
- 4) Give the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees access to North Koreans in China.
