Hosted by Pastor Eun Woo Park of First Korean Presbyterian Church of MD, Suzanne Scholte, Sin-U Nam and Moon Kook-Han of the International Coalition to Save the NK Slaves; the North Korea Genocide Exhibit will be visiting this area as part of its World Tour. The Exhibit, which opened in Seoul in November 2004 and moved to DC and LA in the U.S., depicts the plight and suffering of North Koreans due to starvation and oppression, North Korean refugees in China, political prison camps, Japanese Abductees, Korean War Abductees and other horrific truths of Kim Jong-il's brutal regime. Video footage of public executions that took place in North Korea as recently as March 2005, the award winning documentary **Seoul Train** by Incite Productions and BBC's documentary special, **Access to Evil**, as well as other videos about North Korea will be shown continuously. Also part of the exhibit are satellite images of political prison camps provided by the US Committee for Human Rights in North Korea and the famous painting "**Death and Despair**" by Korean-French artist Jean-Baptiste Oh.
