Here is our day by day report:

Saturday, April 24(Washington, DC/Sunday April 25(Seoul)

North Korea Freedom Week Opening prayer service organized by Pastor Lim Changho was virtually held in Seoul and folks in the United States joined the prayer service virtually. The prayer service was hosted by the following Pastors in South Korea:

**Rev. Kang Chul-ho (originally from Hamheung, DPRK, now Pastor of Sae-teo Church)**: Prayers for the closing of the North Korea political prison camps and the release of the 200,000 political prisoners. Also, prayers for North Korea including Pyongyang to experience God's restoration and become the Jerusalem of the East once again.

Rev. Song Shin-bok (originally from Chungjin, DPRK, now Pastor of Pyongtaek Hanavision Church): For the collapse of the evil Kim regime and the establishment of a new government that cares about the people of North Korea.

Rev. Kim Simon (originally from Chungjin, DPRK, now Missionary for the Christian Council of North Korea): For the



prompt release of the missionaries who were imprisoned in China for helping North Korean refugees. Also, for the 300,000 North Korean refugees who are currently detained in China, facing fear and danger every day.

**Rev. Seo Debora (originally from Hoeryung, DPRK, now Pastor of Hyangyeon Methodist Church)**: For the media outlets and NGOs around the world to speak out and spread the grim reality of the people of North Korea, North Korean refugees, and the horrendous human rights violations against them.

**Rev. Kim Gang-oh (originally from Chungjin, DPRK, now Pastor of North Central Church)**: For the younger generation, church leaders, and political leaders in South Korea to spearhead the endeavors to save the lives of the people of North Korea with courage and discernment.

Pastor Hyun Beepa (originally from Musan, DPRK, now a North Korean missionary for Hallelujah Church): For God's compassion for the people of North Korea who are suffering from COVID-19 and the ensuing economic distress.

Pastor Kim Young-nyo (originally from Siniju, DPRK, now Pastor for Jeju Joosomang Church): For the rampant human rights violations against North Korean refugees in China and forceful repatriation back to North Korea. Also, for God's protection over underground churches in China and North Korea.

Rev. Lim Chang-ho (Chairman of the Christian Council of North Korean, founder and Pastor of Jangdaehyun Church in Busan): For God's answer to all the aforementioned prayers. Also, for the evangelization of North Korean refugees around the world that they would go back to North Korea and rebuild a nation in Christ once the day of unification comes.

#### Sunday, April 25

**NKFW Opening Ceremony** was held in Seoul and folks in the U.S. joined the ceremony virtually. The opening ceremony began with a video showing excerpts of messages that U.S. Members of Congress sent to Free North Korea Radio expressing their hopes and dreams for the North Korean people for 2021 Korean New Year. 

Thank you for not only standing with the millions of North Koreans who continue to have their dignity and human rights violated by the Kim regime but also raising awareness of North Korea's egregious human rights situation, investigating abuses and violations, supporting access to independent information for the North Korean people, and working with the United Nations and likeminded allies to promote accountability for the Kim regime.

On this occasion of North Korea Freedom Week, we stand with the millions of North Koreans who continue to have their dignity and human rights violated by one of the most repressive and totalitarian states in the world, including the more than 100,000 individuals who suffer unspeakable abuses in the regime's political prison camps. We are appalled by the increasingly draconian measures the regime has taken, including shoot-to-kill orders at the North Text of US State Department Statement: On this occasion of North Korea Freedom Week, we stand with the millions of North Koreans who continue to have their dignity and human rights violated by one of the most repressive and totalitarian states in the world, including the more than 100,000 individuals who suffer unspeakable abuses in the regime's political prison camps. #### Monday, April 26

OPEN HEARTS: Thank you to Nicholas Eberstadt and Olivia Schieber of the American Enterprise Institute and David Maxwell of the Foundation for the Defense of Democracies for an amazing panel session focusing on the topic: Open Hearts, opening the hearts of those in power to the DPRK. The three hosts were joined by several high ranking North Korean escapees—Mr. Huh Kwang-il of the Committee for the Democratization of North Korea, Mr. Kim Hyung-soo of Stepping Stones, Mr. Ju Kyung-bae, and Ms. Ju Il-kyung. The North Korean eyewitnesses discussed the human rights situation in North Korea AND in South Korea, and the discussed the ways to reach the elites in power in North Korea to open their hearts to the truth and why that has become more difficult under the current government in South Korea. Among the exciting information shared was how powerful outside information was for "washing away" decades of propaganda.

#### Wednesday, April 28

Thank you to Alana Johnson for compiling powerful prayers that were shared on the website as a guide for prayers and fasting that day. Thank you to Anna Yang for creating a website for those who wanted to join from around the world and share their prayers for North Korea's freedom. Some examples from friends of the people of North Korea from around the world that were sent in and posted on the website: "O Lord, hear; O Lord, forgive. O Lord, pay attention and act. Delay not, for your own sake, O my God, because your city and your people are called by your name (Daniel 9:19)." Amen! from a friend of the people of North Korea in Canada. "Praying for all Christian prisoners in Communist Korea! Thank you! And may God richly bless you!" from a friend of the people of North Korea in Russia.

OPEN MINDS: THANK YOU to Bruce Klingner and Olivia Enos of the Heritage Foundation for hosting two panel sessions respectively focusing on the topic: Open Minds. Olivia Enos hosted a panel session discussing what opened their minds in North Korea with three North Korean defectors—Choi Jung-ho, Choi Keum-nam, and Kim Ji-young. They shared what and how they learned about the outside world everything from K-pop to K-dramas, from foreign radio broadcasts to loudspeakers, from leaflets to other methods. The second panel session was hosted by Bruce Klingner and featured three North Korean defectors—Kim Seong-min of Free North Korea Radio, Choi Jung-hoon of the North Korea People's Liberation Front, and Jang Se-yul of Geuraeyul Unification Association) who discussed ways to open the minds of the people of North Korea. All three North Korean defectors emphasized the importance of sending outside information into North Korea.



\*Note **Park Sang Hak and Park Jung Ho** were originally scheduled to join the Heritage Foundation session but had to go into hiding in order to carry out the North Korea Freedom Week balloon launch which was successfully accomplished.

OPEN BORDERS: THANK YOU to the Dr. Pavel Klein of the Isabella Foundation for hosting a panel session on the topic: Open Borders. The panel session featured four North Korea defectors—Dr. Lee Ae-ran of the Center for Free Unification Culture, Mr. Lee Yi-ruk, Ms. Han Soo-ae, and Ms. Kim Hee-yeon—who explained in great detail the current state of the vulnerable population in North Korea especially orphans and how the international community can ameliorate the dire



circumstance by providing humanitarian assistance but only when it can be certain it is not misused by the regime.

### Thursday, April 29

Thank you to the North Korea Freedom Coalition and translators Helen Park and Johnny Park for opening its regular monthly meeting to the general public to discuss ways to bring freedom to North Korea, improve human rights, and support the work of North Korean defectors in South Korea. The online meeting featured top leaders among North Korean defectors—Huh Kwang-il of the Committee for the Democratization of North Korea, Choi Jung-hoon of the North Korea People's Liberation Front, Jang Se-yul of Geuraeyul Unification Association, Kim Hyung-soo of Stepping Stones, Dr. Lee Ae-ran of Center for Free Unification Culture, and Kim Seong-min of Free North Korea Radio. The defector leaders urged the international community to be more involved in supporting the work of North Korean defectors. The six North Korean defectors and the members of the coalition had a meaningful time exchanging ideas to strengthen ongoing cooperation.

Friday, April 30 in Washington, DC//Saturday, May 1st in Seoul

Closing ceremony in Seoul; Visit to the Embassy of the Republic of Korea in Washington, D.C. While the closing ceremony of the 18th NKFW was virtually held in Seoul. members of the North Korean Freedom Coalition in the Washington, D.C. area delivered a letter for President Moon Jae-in to the Republic of Korea Embassy to rescue North Korean refugees who are currently detained in China and two women who were recently handed back to their abusers. Under the South Korean Constitution, these refugees are entitled to South Korean nationality, hence South Korean government is legally obligated to rescue and bring them safely to South Korea. While NKFC members stood across the street from the Embassy holding the photos of the North Korean refugees who are currently detained in China, the letter was hand-delivered by Suzanne Scholte (President of Defense Forum Foundation and Chair of the North Korea Freedom Coalition) and BJ Choi.
